Senate Judiciary will Vote Thursday on Three Anti-Highlands Nominees to the Highlands Council

The Senate Judiciary Committee is meeting Thursday April 28th, at 10am to vote on four nominations for the Highlands Council. One of them, Jim Rilee, mayor of Roxbury and a vocal opponent of the Highlands Act, is a particularly poor choice to serve on the Highlands Council (see part of his record of opposition [here](#)).

The Judiciary Committee held off voting on two terrible nominees at its previous meeting largely in response to your outrage and the volume of telephone calls Senate members received (from YOU-- thank you!), as well as the large turnout at the Judiciary Committee hearing.
