### At the National Park Service Public Hearings on the draft Environmental Impact Statement for the Susquehanna-Roseland Line!

Tell the National Park Service (NPS) to adopt the "No Build Alternative" as the Preferred Alternative in the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and Record of Decision for the Susquehanna-Roseland 500kV Transmission Line!

In the Draft EIS, the NPS analyzed the effects of the proposed project. It found that project construction activities would result in extensive adverse impacts and unavoidable damages to environmental, recreational, visual and cultural resources of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreational Area, the Appalachian Trail, and the Middle Delaware National Scenic River. NPS proposed "No Build" as the only environmental alternative. Attend one of the 3 public hearings on the Draft EIS and tell NPS to adopt "No Build" as the Final Preferred Alternative in the Final EIS.

**NPS needs to see that the public broadly supports its recommendation if it is to deny determined and influential utility interests!**
