

## Highlands Council Members as of August, 2010

Requirements summarized from the 2004 Highlands Act:

15 total members:

- 8 members from the 7 counties (Bergen, Hunterdon, Morris, Passaic, Sussex, and Warren). Of the 8, 5 must be elected officials and no more than 4 of one political party. The County with the largest population gets 2 seats but must split political affiliation. Elected officials are designated as such, because they were appointed while in office, not necessarily that they are still in public office.
- 7 members from the public with some expertise in natural resource management. At least 4 of these 7 members must either live or work in the Highlands, or drink Highlands's water.
